Homework expectations

Reading: your child will be sent home each week with a reading book linked to their phonics learning, for some children reading levels may have altered since the summer term. We believe it is very important to foster your child's love of reading, so if your child's book appears easier than you might expect it may be because we would like to secure their phonics skills further at this stage. Please don't hesitate to speak to us if you have any concerns. Please hear your child read or read to your child **every day** for 15 minutes and write a comment/ signature in their diary and note what page they read up to.

Please look on seesaw regularly, as we will be posting phonics related content for you to use with your child at home.

Spellings: We will soon be issuing your child spelling shed log in, please use this to practice weekly spellings.

Homework: Every Friday, the children will receive homework to complete. This will include work on mymaths, spelling shed, times table rockstars and optional work for foundation subjects. Homework should be completed and handed in by the following Wednesday.

TT Rockstars and Numbots: Times table rocks stars is a website that the children have a login for which supports children in learning and remembering their times tables. Please login to TTRS and Numbots as much as you can to support your child's fluency of their times tables. We encourage children to login for 5 minutes 4-5 times a week.

PE Lessons

PE lessons are taught by Mr Tyrrell. PE and dance will be taught by Miss Murray, this will take place on a Monday and Tuesday.

What to bring to school

While we provide a school snack during the mornings, we like to encourage the children to bring in a healthy snack to have during the afternoon. Please ensure that your child comes to school with a named water bottle and labelled clothing. Please also ensure your child brings in their reading record and reading book each day.
